The pick-up will be in April, May and June, and then again in September, October and November. Township workers will, for a fee –as set forth below- pick-up at roadside, piles of yard waste which will be ground up and transported for recycling. Applications must be filed by the last week of the preceding month.

These rules must be followed or piles will be rejected!

- 1. No clearing of woods
- 2. No old firewood
- 3. No lumber or building materials
- 4. No metal, nails, screws, or wire in any wood
- 5. Hardwood size limit (oak, birch, maple, mulberry) is 12 foot long, 6 inches diameter
- 6. Sort branches by size and stack on piles
- 7. Twigs 1 inch or smaller should be tied up (with string or twine) in 12 inch x 4 foot bundles or placed in <u>paper</u> yard waste bags
- 8. Flower bed waste shall be placed in brown paper yard waste bags
- 9. Yard waste must be placed back 3 foot from the road edge butt end toward the road
- 10. Yard waste piles shall be no more than 4 foot high
- **11.** Yard waste must be placed out <u>by Monday</u> of the collection week
